### The Bank Leadership Institute

#### Creating excellence through leadership

Mission: The Bank Leadership Institute is a five-month program created by the Iowa Bankers Association to enhance the leadership, communication and performance skills of upwardly mobile mid- to upper-level bankers. The program establishes a network of future bank leaders who understand and can respond to local and national issues impacting the banking industry.

Design: The program includes five one and one half-day sessions centered on developing skills through creative instruction and active participation. The number of participants is limited to 25 bankers to maintain the effectiveness of small-group instruction.

Curriculum: The curriculum is practical, hard hitting and quality driven. Each session will explore an area of professional interest. Learning will focus on developing a solid understanding of the financial industry and the skills necessary for leadership, which students can practice immediately. Students will attend the IBA Management Conference for their February session. This will give them a chance to see nationally recognized speakers in the industry, and network with bank leaders from accross the state. Graduates of the program will also be offered complimentary attendance to the 2023 IBA Convention as part of our Emerging Leader Program.

Tuition: Tuition is \$400 per session and includes all training and meals. Total cost for the five month program is \$2000. You may be billed monthly or all at once. Please note: \$400 is due for each session, even in the event that a session or part of a session is missed by the applicant. Your registration is a full-tuition commitment. Lodging and transportation to and from each location are not included. No refunds will be offered for cancellations after January 10, 2022. Substitutions will be taken at any time.
